ENVIROMEAT 'Warrawillah' Tambo Upper, East Gippsland

Geoff and Linda Jennings run prime Angus cattle on 'Warrawillah' their Tambo Upper property near Bruthen in East Gippsland. 'Warrawillah' is the local Aboriginal name for twisting waters, as the Tambo river runs through the 350 acre property. The farm comprises 210 acres of fertile river flats, 110 acres of undulating hill country formed by an old volcano and 40 acres of swamp land. The Jennings aim to run a productive and efficient farming operation on the land while managing and improving the environment for future generations.

Farm Biodiversity

When the Jennings Family started farming at 'Warrawillah' 14 years ago there were few native trees and virtually no remnant native vegetation, especially on the river flats where you could only find willows. Over this time with the removal of most of the willows and planting of 5-6000 indigenous trees and shrubs, the Jennings have created native corridors for birds and the fenced off 10 acres of swamp allowing it to regenerate. Geoff and Linda comment that there are more native birds to be seen on the property than ever before.

Water Quality Challenge

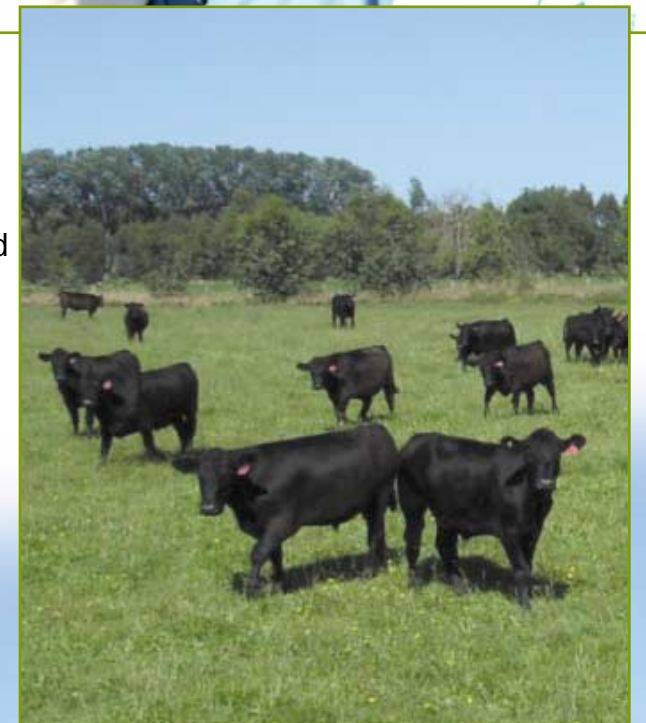
The challenge at Warrawillah is maintaining water quality for both the environment and stock use. This is more relevant than most farming operations as the Tambo river flows through the property and floods the farming land. To improve water quality the Jennings have fenced off all riparian zones along the river, creek and dams to exclude stock, designed the fences to follow the water levels when rising and receding during flood times so stock don't have access to flood water, all stock water is supplied by a reticulated system pumped from the river to individual troughs in each paddock

Stock Management

The Jennings Family has been breeding Angus cattle for 10 years. A combination of good genetics and excellent feed from pasture results in stock that is sought after by feedlots and processors alike for their growth and quality. As a regular supplier to Gippsland Natural over the last five years Warrawillah beef has been awarded "Member of the year" for the past four years.

"We are proud of what we produce and are continually looking at ways to improve the quality, taste and tenderness of our beef and how we produce it while considering our land and environment." Geoff Said.
